

Camp Galilee General Rules For all registered Campers

Registration:

Any person staying overnight past curfew shall be required to register with the Camp Galilee Registrar. Exceptions to this rule must be approved by the Camp Principal. No one under the age of 18 years shall be permitted to register without a signed registration form with the signature of their parent or guardian and their local UPCI Pastor. All Campers, regardless of age, must have a completed registration form with the signature of their local UPC Pastor.

Women/ Young Ladies

Ladies are to wear dresses or skirts. All dresses and skirts must come below the knees while sitting or standing. No slits are to be above the knee. No clothing exposing the midriff will be allowed.

All sleeves must be no shorter than halfway between the shoulder and the elbow. Garments must not exhibit worldly messages or pictures.

All clothing must have non revealing necklines. Tight, body revealing, and see through clothing will not be allowed.

Make up, including fake and painted nails and jewelry will not be permitted, except wedding rings and watches. Hair must be worn in a modest style.

Men and Boys

Men and boys are to wear long pants. All pants should not come below the waist line. Garments with holes or rips or worldly messages or pictures will not be allowed.

All sleeves must be no shorter than halfway between the shoulder and the elbow. Tight, body revealing, and see through clothing will not be allowed.

General rules of conduct

Campers are expected to portray a Christ-like character at all times in both their behavior and actions.

No person shall be allowed in or around a dorm of the opposite sex. This includes all sleeping quarters, block dorms, rooms above the girl's dorm and personal campers. Exceptions; Husband, wife, and children in a private room or camper.

Camp curfew is set at 11:00 pm, at which time all campers are to be in bed with the lights out and no noise unless praying in the tabernacle. Lights must be on in the tabernacle and adult staff or adult supervision shall be present. If service has run late, the Principal will have the authority to extend the curfew past 11:00 pm.

Single Campers are not to couple up, hold hands, or walk arm in arm with the opposite sex.

Radios, TV, CD players, mp3 players, IPODS and video recorders are prohibited in the camper's rooms.

Campers are not to leave the tabernacle after the evening service until the "LEAVE" sign has been posted on the pulpit. (This is only to single youth campers during Family Camp.) Campers are not to leave the grounds without the permission of the Camp principal

Non licensed campers are prohibited from driving any motorized vehicle around the Campgrounds. District vehicle usage must be approved by the Camp Principal.

The lake, including the boat dock, and all other watercraft, and the adjoining property are off limits unless accompanied by a supervisor or parent.

No pets are allowed. Exceptions ADA approved animals, camper must tell the registrar of his/her special needs.

Cell phones must be turned off during all services and after curfew. Any misuse of cell phones or any other personal equipment will result in the confiscation of equipment.

Security

Because of the day we live in, and due to the nature of open Camps with cars coming and going off the Campgrounds throughout all the camps, the following procedures shall be followed.

All licensed pastors staying on the Campgrounds are asked to make themselves available to the Camp Principal for night security. The Camp principal shall pick from this pool of Pastors. This excludes the District Board and Honorary Board members.

All cars entering and exiting the Camp Grounds at night shall be stopped at the gate. A light shall be shown inside the car for safety purposes.
